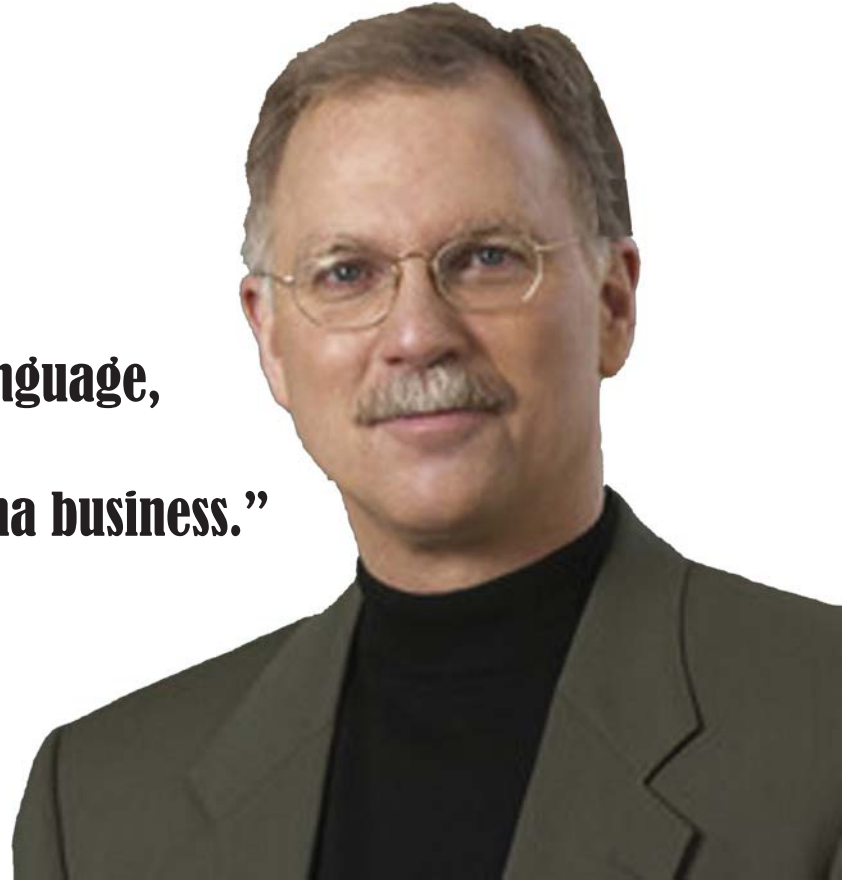


**“While studying a foreign language,
